Exam Dates between 2022 – 2023 expire December 31, 2025.

Medical exam dates between January 2024 & December 2024 will expire December 31, 2027.

Medical exam dates between January 2025 & December 2025 will expire December 31, 2028.

Medical exam dates between January 2026 & December 2026 will expire December 31, 2029.

SOKS is implementing a new annual Athletes Registration Form, this form will need to be completed starting January 1, 2026, also located on ACFlyers.com.

All athletes must have a current SOKS physical form on file with the State office prior to participating in practice, or any other Special Olympics event.

Important dates to mark on your calendar:

Regional Tournament: Saturday, May 16th.

State Tournament Date: Friday, June 5th. Maize High School. (12:00 p.m.)

Key points to remember:

1) Attendance will be monitored. Each athlete will earn the right to attend the Regional & State Tournaments. This means you must attend practice, to attend state competitions.

2) Remember: All coaches are volunteers. Be respectful of their time and dedication to you.

3) All athletes will be registered for the State Tournament unless the Team Director has been informed otherwise.

We ENCOURAGE family members to travel to the state events and experience all that Special Olympics has to offer.

Weather Alert/Rain Plan:

All Cancellation Notices will be posted on our web site and Facebook. The decision to cancel practice due to the weather conditions is a judgment call. We will make every attempt to decide about practice cancellations by 5:00 p.m. on the day of practice. It is your responsibility to ensure we have accurate current contact information on file. Be sure to check your e-mail, or check the Web site, check the Air Capital Flyers Facebook page before heading to practice on days we have questionable weather. Individual text regarding cancellations will not be answered.

If any portion of Wichita (or all of Sedgwick County) is under any type of Severe Weather Warning at practice time, that practice will be canceled.
