General Rules & Sportsmanship:

- 1) Special Olympics Flag Football is non-contact.
- 2) Any player who is involved with rough or unsportsmanlike play will be disqualified from the game. No warning will be issued; the athlete will be disqualified for the remainder of the game.
- 3) All athletes must wear mouth pieces while on the field. (Please purchase your own)
- 4) There are no Fumbles - the ball spotted where it hit the ground.

All athletes must have a current SOKS physical form on file with the State Office prior to participating in practice or the State competition. Physical forms are located on the forms page of ACFlyers.com.

**State Competition: Saturday, July 18, 2026 - Hutchinson Fields, Pittsburgh, KS.
Overnight trip: Travel to Pittsburg on Friday, July 17th.**

Key points to remember:

- 1) **Weekly practice attendance recorded. Each athlete will earn the right to attend the State Tournament. This means you must attend practice to attend competitions.**
- 2) **Participation Fee:** No participation fee for flag football.

- 3) The team pays the Special Olympics Kansas State's \$25.00/athlete registration fee. This registration fee helps cover the cost of the tournament and includes all meals for the athletes on Friday and Saturday.

Athletes are responsible for informing Coach Glenn about your intentions to attend state, or if you are unable to attend. Check your schedules. Athletes not attending the state event without prior notification will receive an invoice to reimburse the team for the \$25.00 registration, transportation, and hotel fees.

State registration call back deadline: July 2nd.

- 4) **Transportation:** The team will cover the cost of transporting the athletes to this tournament via our rental bus or passenger van. Please confirm your travel plans by the first week of practice.
- 5) **Hotel rooms.** Typically, we assign four athletes to a double bed hotel room. We mix the younger athletes with the adult athletes to aid with supervision while at the hotel. However, if you as a parent are traveling with the team and would be more comfortable with your athletes staying in your room, we are fine with those arrangements. The team covers the hotel cost for coach's rooms and athletes staying in a room with other athletes. The team does not make hotel arrangements for parents, or cover the cost of parent's rooms, or rooms where the athletes are staying with parents.

Weather Alert/Rain Plan:

All Cancellation Notices will be posted on our web site and Facebook. The decision to cancel practice due to the weather conditions is a judgment call. We will make every attempt to decide about practice cancellations by 5:00 p.m. on the day of practice. It is your responsibility to ensure we have accurate current contact information on file. Be sure to check your e-mail, or check the Web site, check the Air Capital Flyers Facebook page before heading to practice on days we have questionable weather. An individual text regarding cancellations will not be answered.

If any portion of Wichita (or all of Sedgwick County) is under any type of Severe Weather Warning at practice time, that practice will be canceled.
